REGISTRATION

Registration for GSNC is through the online portal for Netball Australia. The links are included below with instructions. Payment is to be made at the time of registering. <u>REGISTRATIONS CLOSE SUNDAY 1 MARCH 2020.</u>

MEMBERSHIP

The Club invites all Good Shepherd Students, parents and their immediate family members, to register for the 2020 season. Membership is offered only to Good Shepherd families.

WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE (WWVP)

It is a requirement that all volunteers (coaches, umpires and officials) over the age of 18 hold their WWVP (Working with Vulnerable People) Cards. Registration with WWVP is free for volunteers and can be found following this link:

*Note: ACT Junior Championships will be held on 20-21 June (U13-15s) and 4-5 July (U11-12s). *No NCNC rounds are played on these weekends.

LOCATION

The 2020 competition will combine the CNA (Canberra Netball Association) and BNA (Belconnen Netball Association) winter competitions, known as the NORTH CANBERRA NETBALL COMPETITION (NCNC). Some divisions of all categories will play at either of two venues: CNA outdoor courts, Southwell Park, Northbourne Avenue, Lyneham; or BNA outdoor courts, Lhotsky Street, Charnwood.

*The age criteria are based on the age turned by 31 December 2020. ** Time dependent on the division.

Net Set Go! 'Net' Net is the program for 5-7 year olds providing the basic skills for starting netball. The program is delivered by Canberra and Belconnen Netball Association coaches at both locations. (The program does not include matches).

For Good Shepherd this would be Kindergarten children.

Net Set Go! 'Set' a non competitive round robin, no finals are played. <u>Note:</u> Modified game rules apply. For Good Shepherd this would suit players from Years 1-2.

Net Set Go! 'Go' a non competitive round robin, no finals are played. <u>Note:</u> Modified game rules apply but with 10 foot posts. For Good Shepherd this would suit players from Years 3-4. (Year 4 depending on skill level may also play up into the junior category)

FEES

The fee schedule this year <u>does not</u> include the umpire's fees for the 2020 season. Each team is expected to pay their allocated umpire every game. Your team manager will let you know how much this is at the beginning of the grading games. The fee will be between \$20 and \$25 depending on the number of players and numbers of games to be played. The umpire fee is separate to the registration fee.

Family discounts are not offered for the 2020 netball season.

A late fee of \$10 per player may apply for registrations received after the first grading game as per the NCNC schedule.

No refunds will be allowed after 14 March 2020 and will only be considered before this date for an injury or illness. No refunds will be given for a change of mind. Netball Australia/ACT will not process any refunds at any time.

TEAM COMPOSITION

We will endeavour to have each team consist of approximately nine players and the committee will compile teams. However, if there are players who wish to play in a team with another player of the same age group please indicate this when registering. The Club cannot guarantee to meet all preferences but full consideration will be given.

If your child would like to remain in an existing team please say when registering.

Whilst we can try to accomplish the above, please remember that we may not have the exact numbers to make the teams as such and some teams could end up with more or less players depending on registrations. We want to be able to place all players in a team and will do the best we can with what we have.

First preference is given to returning players in existing teams.

TRAINING

Training will take place at the Good Shepherd Netball Courts. Days and times will be finalised in consultation with coaches and players available days.

UNIFORMS

For the 2020 season the girls will be wearing a Good Shepherd Netball dress as their uniform. The dresses have been purchased by the School Council and we are very grateful for this.

For this season ONLY the dresses will be donated to each player with the expectation that the dress will be returned at the end of the season. Each player (or parent of the player) must sign the dress out and if the dress is not returned the player (or parent of the player) will receive an invoice from the school to pay for the dress in full.

Senior dresses need to be purchased by the player.

Boys will be required to wear the Good Shepherd sports uniform as per previous years.

This uniform is the registered uniform for the club and will be worn during games. Please note that tights are not permitted under the dresses on the courts. But black leggings and black long sleeve tops may be worn by Modified/Set and Go players under their dress on those freezing cold days.

COACHES/MANAGERS/UMPIRES

Like all sports, netball relies on volunteers. Our Club looks to parents and senior playing members to assist as coaches, assistant coaches, managers and umpires to support players.

All Go and Junior teams require a Coach, Manager and Umpire. Someone will need to score each week. It is recommended that there is a co coach or assistant coach for the Set teams.

The Club provides team kits and assists coaches and umpires with development and support. A preseason briefing and kit collection will be held once teams have been finalised.

*For Coaches

For coaches it is mandatory that you do the Australian Sports Commission 'Foundation Online Coach Accreditation' online course. The course contains ten modules, covering a range of general coaching topics including the role and responsibilities expected of a coach, planning, safety, working with parents, communication, group management and inclusive coaching practices. This course must be completed by 7 June 2020 then the proof of purchase plus the certificate of completion is to be submitted to obtain a refund from the school. PRESENTATION DAYS AND AWARDS

Presentation events are held at the end of the season and all 'Set', 'Go' Junior and Senior players receive recognition for their participation. In addition, the coach will choose a player to receive the Coaches Award for a Player's contribution and commitment throughout the season.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR 2020

Each member will need to log into their own MyNetball account. All existing members (previous players/coaches) have a MyNetball ID. New members can search MyNetball to see if they have an existing account and if not will be able to create one. Payment is made at the time of Registration online only and incurs a small transaction fee from the provider.
